
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 10" juniper brs S71 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 278.1' dist mkd C-N1/16S5 BT. A 11" juniper brs N12 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 186.7' dist mkd C-N1/16S5 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post West. of corner and attached sign 54-9 & 54-2.

Compass declination  $19^{\circ}$  East.
