
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

None. Corner established with this survey.



Description of corner evidence found:

NOTE: BLM Administrative Corner (steel fence post) brs S18 W, 48' dist. - this post has a BLM tag.

A $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe (origin unknown) & old USFS location poster brs S85 W, 34.1' from corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 10" in ground to bedrock and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 9" ponderosa pine brs $S62\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$, 22.0' dist mkd C-S1/16S5 BT. A 10" ponderosa pine brs $S01^{O}W$, 22.3' dist mkd C-S1/16S5 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9 & 54-2.

Compass declination 190 East.
