
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 7" in ground to bedrock and surrounded with mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 7" juniper brs $859^{\circ}E$, 59.7' scribed N1/16S9 BT. A 9" ponderosa pine brs 874°_{2} W, 26.1' scribed N1/16S8 BT

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 190 East.
