
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

SECS 21,22,27,& 28, MARKED WITH 2 NOTCHES ON S.
AND 3 NOTCHES ON THE E. EDGES AND RAISED MOUND OF
STONE 2 FT HIGH, 4.5 FT BASE ALONGSIDE."

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

RE-ESTABLISHED THE CORNER BY DOUBLE PROPORTION BY HOLDING THE FOUND 3-1/4" ALUMINUM CAP AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29 AND THE 2-1/2" BRASS CAP AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27 IN THE EAST-WEST DIRECTION, AND THE FENCE LINE INTERSECTION AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16 AND THE REPLACED STONE AT THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 28 IN THE NORTH-SOUTH DIRECTION.

SET 3-1/4" ALUMINUM CAP ON A 5/8"X30" IRON ROD UP 4", WITH POST AND PADDLE 1 FOOT SOUTHWESTERLY.

THE CAP IS MARKED AS SHOWN BELOW.

THE REFERENCES SET FOR SAID CORNER ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1) A 5/8" X 30" SMOOTH IRON ROD WITH A 1-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP, FLUSH, STAMPED "ODOT" BEARS \$79°50'17"E, 10.09 FEET.
2) A 5/8" X 30" SMOOTH IRON ROD WITH A 1-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP, FLUSH, STAMPED "ODOT" BEARS \$09°45'51"E, 8.90 FEET.
3) A 5/8" X 30" SMOOTH IRON ROD WITH A 1-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP, FLUSH, STAMPED "ODOT" BEARS \$63°38'12"W, 7.65 FEET.
4) A 5/8" X 30" SMOOTH IRON ROD WITH A 1-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP, FLUSH, STAMPED "ODOT" BEARS \$13°45'52"E, 8.09 FEET.
