

At position by Survey I set a 5/8" X 30" iron pin, 27" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" X 15" iron pin bears South 22°18' West, a distance of 17.19 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SRP".

A 5/8" X 15" iron pin bears North 52°09' West, a distance of 9.68 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NRP".
