



Map showing the boundary survey of section 28 T 12.5 R 43 E W.M. Baker County, Oregon for the mining purposes of Frank H. Pethick of Nevada being surveyed during June, 1967 by James H. Hambleton and party using a Gurli transit and chain. The weather was stormy and it was impossible to take a solar bearing in order to determine a true meridian, thus a magnetic bearing was used as a starting bearing with a declination of 20'00" east. The remainder of the bearings were determined through deflection angles.
