
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1886 by Henry W. Cooke under Contract No. 528.

Set 16"X14"X12" basalt stone, 11" in ground, for 1/4 Section Corner marked 1/4 on West face, from which:

- a pine, 34" in diam., bears N45°E, 83 lks. dist. a pine, 24" in diam., bears $S12^{O}W$, 64 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found original Scribed Bearing Tree

a P.Pine, 24", in diam., bears \$120W, 42.2'

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3" Brass Cap on 2½ galvanized pipe 30" long & buried 24" in ground and surrounded by mound of stone.

New Bearing Trees:

8" P.Pine, $N62\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$, 82.2', Scribed 1/4 S9, B.T. 7" P.Pine, $N89\frac{1}{2}^{O}E$, 19.4', Scribed 1/4 S10,B.T.

All B.T.'s have 54-4 & 54-3 sign attached. Set steel guard post with 54-4 sign attached along side B.C. Painted red band around bearing trees. Tagged trees with L.S. 980 washer.
