A 36" pine stump bears N65°E, 68.6' with visible scribes. A 14" pine stump bears S50°E, 29.7' with visible scribes. A 36" pine stump bears S75°W, 88.4' with visible scribes.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Maintained mound by surrounding with more earth and stone.

New bearing trees:

A 10"p pine bears S163°W, 88.2' dist scribed T13SR36ES3 BT. A 9"p pine bears N273°W, 42.4' dist scribed T12SR36ES34 BT. A 8"p pine bears S583°E, 43.8' dist scribed T13SR36ES2 BT. A 6"p pine bears N54°E, 96.8' dist scribed T12SR36ES35 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band around each BT. Set steel fence post alongside corner and attached sign 54-9.
