
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry W. Cooke under GLO contract no. 528 dated April 10, 1886.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a post  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft long 3 ins square 12 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 S on W face and raised a mound of stone around post  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft high 3 ft base, there being no trees within limits.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Searched 2 hrs and did not find original post or rock mound, most available rocks are in active fence line rock jacks.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At position determined by single proportionate measurement between adjacent recovered section corners North and South...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A ponderosa pine 13" brs N68°E, 80.6' dist marked 1/4S3 BT. A ponderosa pine 21" brs N59°W, 60.7' dist marked 1/4S4 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band around each BT. Set steel fence post along-side corner and attached sign 54-9 and 54-2.

Compass declination 190 East.
