**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner established by Eugene P. McCornack under Contract No. 398 and dated July 02, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set basalt stone 18 x 8 x 7 ins 12 ins in ground for 1/4 Sec Cor marked 1/4 on W face and raised stone mound alongside. Pits impracticable.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

A basalt stone 18 x 8 x 5" (record 18 x 8 x 7") marked 1/4 lying loose in stone mound.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At position of found original stone...

Set 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap 12" in the ground surrounded with a mound of earth & stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried original stone alongside.

New bearing trees established:

A 7" p pine brs S46°E, 148.9' scribed 1/4S1 BT.

A 6" juniper brs N89°E, 80.7' scribed 1/4S36 BT.

New BT's have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT. Set 6' steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9 and 54-2.

Compass declination 19° East.
