### SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, James D. Hanley, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land represented by this partition plat for the City of Unity, Oregon, in accordance with O.R.S. Chapter 92. The boundary of this partition is described as follows: the SWI/4SWI/4SWI/4NEI/4 of Section 15, T. 13 S., R. 37 E., W.M. by U.S.A. Land Patent No. 36-96-0002, recorded in Baker County Deeds 95-45-103, 104, 105 filed November 7, 1995, for a solid waste transfer station. The parcel as staked is shown on the annexed map as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the said parcel which is N. 89° 58' E., 2641.65 feet (40.025 chains) from the West quarter corner of said section: thence N. 0° 02' W., 330.0 feet; thence N. 89° 58' E., 330.0 feet; thence S. 0° 02' E., 330.0 feet; thence S. 89° 58' W., 330.0 feet to the point of beginning.

# NARRATIVE

This survey and partition plat for the City of Unity, Oregon, is for the purpose of marking on the ground a 2.5 acre parcel of patented land described as the SWI/4SWI/4SWI/4NEI/4 of Section 15, T. 13 S., R. 37 E., W.M. The original section subdivision survey performed under GLO Contract No. 409 with G. Henderson, dated August 22, 1881, states he monumented the Section 15 government corners with 6 cottonwood posts, one pine post and one sagebrush post, none of which were recovered for this subject survey. The West quarter corner had subsequently been referenced by the Oregon State Highway Department and was marked by a brass disc set in asphalt highway surface. Recent grinding and repaving of the highway asphalt overlay has destroyed that monument. It's position, however, is known from other recent ties from the center of Section 16 monument and the South quarter corner of the said Section 16. Due to the high but undetermined costs for subdividing Section 15 into it's aliquot parts, I have staked the 2.5 acre parcel using the original survey data and the said West quarter corner position. The tie from the parcel Southwest corner to the sole known quarter corner is shown on the annexed map. The subject corner monuments established by the above described method are considered approximate; however, the location as shown is appropriate and retraceable, similar to a patent mineral survey of a lode
