Narrative

The purpose of this survey is to divide Parcel 3 of Baker County Survey 13-37-25 into 2 parcels, both new parcels being a part of the MacNees Tract which was purchased by the Department of Agriculture, Forest Service and recorded in Deed Book 173 Page 1490 of Baker County, Oregon.

The locations shown were obtained by random traverse using a Lieca 703 electronic total station supported by Carlson Software.

Surveyor's Certificate

I. Carl J. Stout, Registered Professional Land Surveyor, in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I surveyed Parcels 3 and 4 of this partition, situated in SW1/4NW1/4 Section 16, and SE1/4NE1/4 Section 17, Township 13 South, Range 37 East, Willamette Meridian, Oregon in accordance with the statutes of the State of

I designate the 5/8" iron pin that is N00°06'00"W and 619.70' of the 1/4 corner between sections 16 and 17 as the Initial Point of this partition.

Beginning at said Initial Point; thence S89°54'00"W 102.48' to a 5/8" iron pin and the Highway 26 right of way; thence along the Highway 26 easterly right of way S09'46'00"W 123.24' to a 5/8 iron pin; thence N84' 09'10"E 126.00' to a 5/8" iron pin; thence 50.61' along the arc of a 71.58' radius clockwise curve to a 5/8" iron pin; thence N30°19'44"E 73.55' to a 5/8" iron pin; thence N33'48'22"E 70.91' to a 5/8" iron pin; thence S89'54'00"W 168.10' to the Initial Point.
