

ORIGINAL G.L.O. DESCRIPTION: Drove cottonwood post 3 ft long and 2 ins Square for 1/4 Sec cor. Marked 1/4S on W. side. dug pits 20x12x10 ins. E and W of post 5 ft. dist and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high 2½ ft diam. at base around post.

EVIDENCE FOUND: None. after a diligent search, I determine this corner lost and placed a monument by single proportionate measure between the Section Corners to the East and West.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES SET:

At the corner point I set a 5/8"X30" iron pin with attached 2½" aluminum cap, 27 inches the ground. Built a 1 ft. mound of stone around iron pin.

FROM WHICH, I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINTS:

A 5/8"X30" iron pin bears S.46°46'E., 23.31 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING

A 5/8"X30" iron pin bears N.48*18'W., 23.75 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING

ALSO FROM WHICH, I SCRIBE THE FOLLOWING BEARING TREES: A Juniper, 4½" DBH, bears N.65°E., 48.0 ft., marked S1/4 S19 BT

A Juniper, 5" DBH, bears S.58'W., 60.6 ft., marked N1/4 S30 BT



Used RTK GPS to measure Reference Points and bearings to trees. Bearings to RP's and BT's are based on Baker County Survey 13–36–94. Used a steel tape to measure to a 40d nail driven into the side-center of the root crown of BT's. Placed BT tag on Bearing Trees.
