

At position by Survey I set a 5/8" X 30" iron pin, 29" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" X 15" iron pin bears North 39°50' East, a distance of 16.44 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NRP".

A 5/8" X 15" iron pin bears South $47^{\circ}01'$ East, a distance of 18.83 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SRP".

Set steel fence post approx. 0.6 ft. South
