

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 25" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin bears North $45^{\circ}41"$ East, a distance of 12.83 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER N RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 12°34' East, a distance of 12.68 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S RP

Set steel fence post approx. 0.5 ft. Southeasterly

Ancient fence corner to North/West bearing fence lines bears approx. 47 feet North.
