
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner was originally established under GLO contract number 148, dated May 17th, 1871, executed by John S. Kincaid. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set stone 14x10x7 for 1/4 sec. cor.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None. Area is devoid of stone.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 28" in the ground, with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" \times 15" iron pin bears North 52°29' East, a distance of 22.30 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 30°06' East, a distance of 14.91 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP

A $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin bears South 74°03" West, a distance of 17.84 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North 23°28' West, a distance of 25.11 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. South
