
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

This corner was never established.




DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES LESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Set a 3 1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap on a 2 1/2 inch diameter by 30 inch long aluminum post, buried 20 inches in the ground, with clear DEEP-1 magnet at base and raised a stone mound 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high.

A galvanized steel post placed south, 5.2 feet, cap is marked as shown:



From which: lestablish the following references:

A silver DEEP-1 magnet, buried 6 inches in the ground, bears N. 38° E., 7.30 ft.

A pink DEEP-1 magnet, buried 6 inches in the ground, bears S. 60° E., 7.95 ft.

A blue DEEP-1 magnet, buried 6 inches in the ground, bears S. 26° W., 7.25 ft.

A orange DEEP-1 magnet, buried 6 inches in the ground, bears N. 52° W., 6.15 ft.
