Set a 5/8 inch diameter by 30 inches long iron rod (rebar) with 3 1/4 inches diameter aluminum cap, driven 30 inches in the ground, with rock collar, marked as shown. A galvanized steelpost placed north 3 feet.



From which: lestablish the following references:

A + (cross) chiseled into large boulder, 4.5 ft. by 3.5 ft. by 2.5 ft. high, embedded in slope, with "BO" chiseled into face below said mark, boulder sits above old stage road (gravel), Bears N.12° 45'50"E., 92.54 feet.

A found 5/8 inch diameter iron rod (smooth), down in hole in large sized talus rock at top of slope above Powell Creek, Bears S.87° 40'39"W., 330.34 feet.

NOTE: This iron rod was set circa. 1959 for a parcel that was intended to be acquired by the state but was never purchased. A 4" by 4" wood post is nearby, (sw'ly 0.5 ft.).

The section line between sections 15 and 22 bears north, 6.68 feet from this monument.
