NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO SURVEY, MONUMENT, POST AND SIGN A "CONGRESSIONALLY DESIGNATED BOUNDARY" INTENDING TO FOLLOW THE "MONUMENT ROCK WILDERNESS BOUNDARY", AS SHOWN HEREON IN ACCORDANCE WITH CONTRACT NUMBER 53-04M3-5-0038, DATED JUNE 28, 1995. THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED FOR THE WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST OFFICE IN BAKER CITY, OREGON. THE PROJECT IS LOCATED IN SECTIONS 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, AND 24 OF TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 35 1/2 EAST AND SECTIONS 7, 8, 16, 17, AND 18 OF TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, BAKER COUNTY, OREGON.

THE CONTROL POINTS FOR THIS PROJECT WERE ESTABLISHED BY GPS METHODS, UTILIZING SIX TRIMBLE 4000SE, SINGLE FREQUENCY, 12 CHANNEL GPS RECEIVERS. THE FINAL GPS COORDINATES ARE SHOWN ON COUNTY SURVEY 14-36-34 AS FILED WITH THE BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE.

THE TIE LINES SHOWN HEREON ARE FROM GPS CONTROL POINTS TO THE TRUE BOUNDARY ANGLE POINT POSITION, NOT TO THE ANGLE POINT WITNESS CORNERS.

THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS SURVEY WAS A SERIES OF SOLAR OBSERVATIONS, TAKEN AT EACH GPS CONTROL STATION, COMPUTED BY THE HOUR-ANGLE METHOD AND REDUCED TO GRID NORTH. THE MAGNETIC DECLINATION WAS NOT DETERMINED. ALL BEARINGS AND DISTANCES SHOWN HEREON ARE OREGON STATE PLANE-NORTH ZONE. EXCEPTING BEARING TREE TIES.

ALL BEARING TREE TIES REPORTED HEREON ARE TRUE BEARINGS AND DISTANCES FROM MONUMENT TO THE CENTER OF BEARING TREES.

THE WILDERNESS BOUNDARY SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING A TOPCON 3B TOTAL STATION INSTRUMENT ALONG WITH A HEWLETT PACKARD 48SX CALCULATOR WITH TRIPOD DATA SYSTEMS 48 (V 4.0 SX) DATA COLLECTION

THE WILDERNESS BOUNDARY SURVEY CONSISTED OF NUMEROUS CLOSED TRAVERSES RUN ALONGSIDE THE CONGRESSIONALLY DESIGNATED BOUNDARY. THE BOUNDARIES METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION IS IDENTIFIED BY BOTH TOPOGRAPHIC FEATURES AND ELEVATIONS. ELEVATION CONTROL WAS BASED UPON KNOWN NGS MONUMENTS IN THE VICINITY AND TIED IN THE GPS CONTROL SURVEY AS SHOWN ON COUNTY SURVEY 14-36-34. ONE GLO CORNER WAS INCLUDED IN THE DESCRIPTION, AP 1541, WHICH IS THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH RANGE 35 1/2 EAST. THE ORIGINAL BASALT STONE AND REMAINS OF ONE BEARING TREE WERE FOUND AND USED TO REESTABLISH THIS CORNER.

THE ANGLE POINTS MARKED BY THIS SURVEY WERE MONUMENTED WITH ALUMINUM PIPE MONUMENTS AND BRASS CAPS AS NOTED AND SHOWN HEREON AND REFERENCED AND POSTED TO USFS SPECIFICATIONS. THE WILDERNESS BOUNDARY LINE WAS POSTED AS PER THE REQUEST OF THE COR WITH USFS WILDERNESS BOUNDARY SIGNS, NUMBER 27-6a, NAILED TO TREES OR RIVETED TO 6 FOOT ALUMINUM "U" CHANNEL POSTS ALONG THE CONGRESSIONALLY DESIGNATED BOUNDARY AT NOMINAL 200 FOOT INTERVALS.

ALL MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED DURING THIS PROJECT WERE SET BETWEEN JULY AND SEPTEMBER, 1995.

A COPY OF ALL FIELD NOTES MADE ON THIS PROJECT WAS SUBMITTED AS A PORTION OF THE PROJECT REPORT TO THE CONTRACT OFFICER REPRESENTATIVE WITH THE WILLOWA—WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST.

THE CONGRESSIONALLY DESIGNATED BOUNDARY OF THE MONUMENT ROCK WILDERNESS AREA WAS DETERMINED ACCORDING TO THE METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION SUPPLIED BY THE USFS. THE ANGLE POINT POSITIONS WERE DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:
