## Description of corner evidence found:

A pine 48 ins diam with fragmentary scribes visible on partially healed and burned blaze for section 1 BT

No trace of section 36 BT which has apparently been destroyed by logging road construction.

No trace of original corner stone.

Corner position reestablished at record position from remaining original accessory.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch aluminum cap on a 2 inch aluminum pipe 30 inches long, 25 inches in the ground with 5 inches projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

and 54-9 below a 6 inch band of red paint.

New bearing tree established: A pine 14 ins diam bears N  $30\frac{1}{2}$  W, 31.0 ft dist marked 1/4S36BT. This new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint around. To the original bearing tree, attached signs 54-3
