## Description of corner evidence found:

A pine 45 ins diam with scribes "4SBT" visible on open and pitched over blaze for section 36 original BT.

No trace of section 25 original bearing tree.

A granite stone 14x10x6 ins lying loose and downhill of reestablished corner position with 1/4 chisled on smooth face.

NOTE: Blaze and scribes are not oriented properly with record bearing recorded in official GLO record and loder tags dated 9-25-61 and 9-10-64 indicate record bearing and distance to be "N 26" W, 7½ ft". It appears that there is a transposition error in the duplicate or triplicate sets of the official record. Corner position reestablished in accordance with the official record....N 65° W, 16 lks (10.7 ft).

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ inch aluminum cap on a 2 inch aluminum pipe 30 inches long, 25 inches in the ground with 5 inches projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached. Buried stone alongside.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing tree established: A fir 6 ins diam bears N  $02\frac{1}{2}^{O}$  W, 35.4 ft dist marked 1/4S25BT.

new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint around. To the original bearing tree , attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 below a 6 inch band of red paint.
