Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original stone.

A fir snag 28 ins dia bears N85°E, 32 ft with bark scribe "1/4S2 BT", not an original BT.

A dead mahognay 10 ins dia bears S30°W, 19 1ks with scribes "1/4S BT" on open blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by reversed record bearing and distance from sec 11 BT...

Set a 2½" aluminum cap on a 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in the ground with 5" projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

The original BT and the fir snag have signs 54-3 and 54-4 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.

New bearing trees established: A fir 8 ins dia bears $N10^{\circ}E$, 21.6 ft dist marked 1/4S2 BT. A fir 12 ins dia bears S74 $^{\circ}$ 30'W, 26.1 ft dist marked 1/4S11 BT.

Each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to BT blaze and has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.
