Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original basalt stone.

A pine 44 ins dia bears N20°W, 56 1ks with fragmentary scribes on open blaze. A dead mahogany 6 ins dia bears S70°W, 52 1ks with full record scribes on open blaze. A windblow pine 30 ins dia bears S60°E, 71 1ks with fragmentary scribes on open blaze. A windblow pine 16 ins dia bears N40°E, 77 lks dist with fragmentary scribes on open blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by reversed record bearing and distance from secs 11 & 14 BT's...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in the ground with 5" projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a $\bar{6}^{\, \text{!}}$ fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

The original BT's have signs 54-3 and 54-4 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.

New bearing trees established: A pine 8 ins dia bears $\rm N12^{O}E$, 48.5 ft marked T14SR36ES12 BT. A fir 20 ins dia bears $\rm S84^{O}W$, 67.0 ft marked T14SR36ES14 BT.

Each new bearing tree have brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and have signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.

No other trees available in healthy condition, therefore marked the SW corner of rock slab 30' \times 15' \times 5' B \times 0 which bears S85°E, 13.8 ft, painted said corner red and attached signs 54-3 and 54-9.
