A green pine 40 ins dia bears N30°E, 76 1ks dist with fragmentary scribes on open blaze.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by reversed record bearing and distance from original BT...

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in the ground with 5" projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

The original BT has signs 54-3 and 54-4 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.

New bearing tree established:

A juniper 10 ins dia bears S77°W, 80.7 ft dist marked 1/4S8 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.
