## Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original post or stone.

A green pine 24 ins dia bears  $N15^{\circ}E$ , 66 lks dist with healed blaze. A sawed pine stump bears  $S64^{\circ}E$ , 35 lks dist, 50 ins dia with lower blaze. A sawed pine stump 30 ins dia bears  $S12^{\circ}W$ , 60 lks dist with lower blaze.

A sawed pine stump 20 ins dia with "T" scribe visible, bears N200W, 41 1ks dist.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by reversed record bearing and distance from original BT's...

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on a 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in the ground with 5" projecting out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

The original BT and stumps have signs 54-3 and 54-4 attached and a 6 inch band of red paint around.

New bearing trees established: A fir 6 ins dia bears N31°30'W, 19.0 ft dist marked T15SR37ES5 BT. A fir 10 ins dia bears S38°30'E, 75.5 ft dist marked T15SR37ES9 BT. A pine 11 ins dia bears S39°W, 58.3 ft marked T15SR37ES8 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.
