No trace of original stone.

A green fir 28 ins dia bears  $N05^{\circ}E$ , 21 lks dist with fully healed blaze. A live mahogany 9 ins dia bears  $S86^{\circ}W$ , 27 lks dist with fragmentary scribes in open blaze.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by distance intersection from recovered original BT's... Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in ground with 5" proj. out of ground with a 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown.

The original BT's have signs 54-3 and 54-4 attached below a band of red paint.
