



NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey for Floyd Ingram is to mark on the ground the East 1/2 of Lot 11 and all of Lot 12, BLK. 17, Huntington Townsite. The original map of Huntington is filed in County Plat Book No.1, Page 48, dated April 8, 1886. The plat describes "four permanent corners having been established at points "A", "B", "C", and "D". All monumentation marking these points was recovered, consisting of the following: "A" monument at 1st and Washington is now a 5/8 inch rebar; "B" monument at 6th and Washington is the original 2 1/2 inch X 4 inch steel plate; "C" monument at 6th and Monroe is now a 1 inch diam. iron rod; "D" monument at 1st and Monroe is now a 2 1/2 inch diam. brass cap in concrete. Further explanation is found in survey 14-44-14. The record bearing between "A" and "D" of N. 04° 28' E. is held this survey.

SURVEY TIES

From the intersection of 3rd street E. and Adams Street:

Monument "A" bears N. 04° 29' 23" W., 296.67 feet along 3rd Street E. centerline to Washington Street centerline; thence S. 85° 29' 57" W., 1519.71 feet along Washington Street.

Monument "B" bears N. 85° 29' 57" E., 1139.77 feet from 3rd Street E. and Washington Street centerlines intersection.

Monument "A" to monument "B" is N. 85° 29' 57" E., 2659.48 feet.
